Norwich University of the Arts: MA Application Guidance Notes

Application Process

1. Complete the application form, including a well-prepared and considered 500 word statement indicating your

intentions for MA study. The form should be word-processed, not hand-written.

2. Detach the Reference Form and forward to your chosen referee with a request to complete and return to NUA at

the email address indicated.

3. Send the completed form to admissions@nua.ac.uk.

4. We will endeavour to contact you within two weeks of receiving your application and reference from your

nominated referee. If your application is acceptable we will arrange a date for interview.

Interview Process

If you are invited to interview, we will ask you to bring a portfolio of recent work with you. You will be interviewed by

one or more members of the MA course team who will ask you about your work, your applicant statement and your

preparedness for postgraduate study. You will be given an opportunity to ask the course team questions. The

interview normally lasts around thirty minutes and we will endeavour to let you know if you have been successful

within five days of your interview.

N.B. Applicants to MA Curation who do not have a visual arts background should prepare a critical text rather than a

portfolio. The text should be between 800 and 1000 words which analyses and compares two recently viewed

exhibitions, events or festivals from a curatorial perspective. You may wish to consider, for example: audience, space,

environment, concepts etc. You should submit the text at least one week before your interview.

If you are unable to travel to Norwich in person for interview, please prepare a digital portfolio and submit it either

with your application form or at least one week before your interview. The interview will take place using Skype or

telephone.
